She asked for input from the other Board Members. The consensus was that the Resolution passed years ago to not offer health insurance to elected or appointed officials was suffice and it was not necessary to pass a Local Law, however, it will be discussed further at the next Board Meeting.
- d) At the next Board meeting the idea of zoning four sites as commercial will be presented along with the suggestion to reduce the needed acreage from five acres to three acres.
- e) Deputy Supervisor Virginia Wilbur stated that the Franchise Agreement with Spectrum will need to be reviewed further at the next Board Meeting.
- f) Deputy Supervisor Virginia Wilbur reported the Town Attorney is in the process of reviewing the idea to create a tax/fee on mass gatherings. This will be further discussed at the next Board Meeting.
- g) Deputy Supervisor Virginia Wilbur reported that the Board will need to begin negotiations with the Union on the contract with the Town.
