TOWN OF HANNIBAL REGULAR BOARD MEETING AUGUST 15, 2018 7:00 PM

Supervisor Virginia Wilbur called the meeting to order at 7:00pm with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag; Town Clerk Denise Hafner opened with a prayer.

Public Session:

- Supervisor Virginia Wilbur explained that a three minute limit will apply for those who wish to speak and a sign in sheet was provided.
- Dan Hofmann questioned Supervisor Virginia Wilbur why she wanted to be the Town Supervisor and why nothing was being done with the Planning Board situation.
- Carol Darling asked for clarification on the list of alternate members for the Zoning Board of Appeals. Several names were listed that were no longer alternates to the ZBA. It was pointed out that an alternate position is a one year term.
- Oswego County Legislator Terry Wilbur informed the public that the County was in the process of paving County Route 36, County Route 21, County Route 85, the Transfer Station Road and Cooper Road. He explained that money from a Bond was being used to help with the cost. He also stated that the County was beginning work on the upcoming 2019 budget and again will be looking at ways to keep the budget at a 0% increase in taxes.
- Leslie Thompson stated that an application to the Zoning Board of Appeals for a Variance is done when there is a violation involved. She stated that there were no violations cited in the application for a gravel mine permit on Harris Hill Road and that the DEC did not find any violations with setbacks on the haulage road for the gravel mine. Due to the way the Planning Board has handled the application for the Harris Hill Mine, she assured the Town Board that an Article 78 will be filed.
- Eugene Hafner asked Legislator Terry Wilbur if the Emergency Plan for the Town should be revised since the Plan for the County had been updated and especially due to the changes in Town positions. He also questioned whether the people who are supposed to be part of the plan are aware that they are involved. Legislator Terry Wilbur stated that the current Town Supervisor, Town Clerk and Highway Superintendent must be part of the plan. He also stated the Fire Chief would also be involved.

• Supervisor Virginia Wilber closed the public session.
